






### **CINEQUEST AI DAY & TOWN HALL** MARCH 6, HAMMER THEATRE CENTER

Preceding the festival, on March 6th at the Hammer Theatre Center, Cinequest hosts a meeting of the minds, politicians, creatives, and our community to tackle the opportunities as well as the potential issues of Al for communities. 
