To land the job, his boss gives him a seemingly impossible list of tasks to complete. If Carter can conquer this wildly chaotic day, he might be ready for the real world after all.

Get Lucky

After months of trying to get pregnant, but having no luck, Tim and Cathryn go to a fertility specialist who suggests they go the IVF route. But with a price tag of \$25K, desperation sets in and Tim's big plan is to "earn" the money as a bank job getaway driver. However, Tim's day is about to get even more complicated. **(World Premiere)**

Good Sport

Pat is a divorced coach of his son's youth basketball team. As if the stressors of the game aren't enough, he is also forced to confront pressures from an angry business owner to whom he owes money. **(World Premiere)**

With the help of her boyfriend, she hatches a plan to make a sex tape of her stepdad to frame him for cheating. Things get messy. **(World Premiere)**

King Baby

A modern fairytale plays out in a crumbling "Kingdom" populated only by a King and a Servant. The arrival of a mannequin Queen throws their carefully constructed world into chaos. **(US Premiere)**

Set against the backdrops of Shanghai, Wuhan, and Chongqing, the Chinese film follows the intertwined fates of Xia Yo, a woman trapped in a controlling and abusive relationship, and Xu Zitai, a man grappling with terminal illness, and their chance encounter with each other.

Cat's Cry

Milena's dreams and aspirations for the future are challenged when she gives birth to a baby with a rare genetic condition. Her father urges Milena to return home, offering to help raise the child. Overwhelmed and fearful of her future, Milena disappears, leaving her parents to fight a flawed social system. **(US Premiere)**

Holding On, Letting Go

Eight short films exploring what happens when we try to hold on as things slip away — whether traditions, relationships, or life. These films, from seven countries, ask hard questions about identity, choices, and change through live-action and animated storytelling.

In The Name Of Fire

Winner Golden Goblet Awards for Best Actor and Best Director in Asian New Talent section at Shanghai International Film Festival: In a secluded village in India, Phekan and Rukhiya face trials; he must travel to find work and she waits in their eerie home, haunted by whispers branding her a witch. One ominous night pushes her to the brink.

La Gloria

David Morse (*The Green Mile*, *12 Monkeys*) in an absolutely enthralling story about a border rancher mistakenly shoots a migrant woman and must decide whether or not to help her and risk discovery by his son, a Border Patrol agent.

Moonlight Warrior

Dou falls in love with a pretty nurse, Jiahui. Unfortunately, Jiahui belongs to a ruthless mobster, Gang, who is brutal to her. Dou becomes Jiahui's protector, her *Moonlight Warrior*, but before he comes to harm, Jiahui and Gang leave for Japan. Years pass and Jiahui returns. But when Gang pursues his wife, a youthful romance becomes a deadly contest. **(US Premiere)**

Newborn

A beautiful tale following Maria and Nicholas, a young couple in Mexico City, after they receive the shocking news their newborn's sex cannot be determined due to a disorder. Nicholas advocates for following medical protocol, while Maria embarks on a journey of research and self-discovery. Their choice will shape the trajectory of their family's journey in ways they never imagined. **(US Premiere)**

Nora

Having given up her career in music, Nora returns to her hometown to focus on her precocious six-year-old, a new house, a new school year, and the place she deliberately left behind. Her dreams and ambitions, however, have different plans. A joyful, unflinching look at modern motherhood clashing with the artistic notion of pursuing your passion. **(World Premiere)**

Saigon Saigon

A shy, young man and a mysterious girl spend a night together in the city of Saigon. Their mutual attraction develops, and in the morning, they must decide whether their connection is worth pursuing, or if they will go their separate ways. Based on Dostoevsky's short story "*White Nights*." **(World Premiere)**

Tension Release

Nine short films exploring those moments that lead to the dam breaking. Some end explosively, and some fall almost silently into chaos and eternity. These films examine tensions in various settings, exploring the build-up and release, with relatable visions of expectation and reality, war, and peace.

The Bitter Tears of Zahra Zand

The story of Zahra Zand, a high society fashion designer who lives in the fantasy world of her glamorous apartment in 1980s London. Distraught at the loss of her country, she descends into madness and power games with her housekeeper, an elderly religious woman who raised her. **(World Premiere)**

The Friend

Bill Murray, Naomi Watts, and a charismatic Great Dane named Bing propels this wise and insightful story of love, friendship, and healing in which a writer adopts a Great Dane that belonged to a late friend and mentor. Based on the acclaimed novel by Sigrid Nunez.

The Long Run

When two oddball strangers leave their lives behind to chase their Hollywood dreams, they discover what they lack in talent, they make up for with determination and a shared delusion, leading to an unexpected friendship that will make them question the realities of chasing a dream. **(World Premiere)**

The Luckiest Man In America

An all-star cast including Paul Walter Hauser, David Strathairn, Walton Goggins, Johnny Knoxville, Patti Harrison, and Haley Bennett, the true story of the man who stepped on to the stage of "Press Your Luck" harboring a secret: the key to endless money.

The Move In

During the first night in their new home, Ana and Diego hear noises that seem to indicate someone broke into the house. Diego is paralyzed by fear. Ana, on the other hand, handles the situation. The shame Diego feels makes him deny what happened—leading him to confront Ana, his manhood, and with the way he relates to his son. **(World Premiere)**

The Summer Book

Glenn Close (*Fatal Attraction*, *Dangerous Liaisons*, *The Big Chill*) stars in the beautiful story of a nine-year-old girl who is growing up fast, and her grandmother, who is nearing the end of her life. Their summer together will change them both in dramatic ways. Based on Tove Jansson's beloved novel.

Village Keeper

A widow paralyzed by anxiety struggles to protect her kids in a city gripped by violence. Finding solace in cleaning, she inadvertently uncovers her own long-buried trauma while tidying a bloody crime scene. The story of a family grappling with secrets and unanswered rage that spans generations.

Xibalba Monster

When eight-year-old Rogelio is sent away to the Yucatan jungle for the summer, he spends the excruciatingly hot days obsessing over "The Book of Spirits" which awakens in him visions and dreams of ghosts, but above all, of an old man who leaves a trace of death. That is when he finds out the man is known as the "Xibalba Monster." **(US Premiere)**

A Little Fellow: The Legacy of A.P. Giannini

Before banks in the U.S. had a branch on every corner, they were an exclusive service for the wealthy. A.P. Giannini had a dream. His goal was to serve "the little fellow" and breed prosperity. By building trust and giving loans on a simple handshake, he created one of the largest banks in the country – Bank of America. **(US Premiere)**

American Agitators

The inspiring story of influential labor organizer Fred Ross, who trained many activists of note including Dolores Huerta and Cesar Chavez. Cesar Chavez is one of California's most renowned historical leaders. **(World Premiere)**

Art & Artist

Ten films exploring the artistic process, healing, and meaning-making. Featuring dance, love stories, and heavy themes, this program highlights the relationship between art, the artist, and their world.

Bar

Burt

Burt, a spirited street musician with Parkinson's has his daily life shaken up when a wayward young man from New York shows up claiming to be his son. Having always dreamt of being a dad, Burt invites him to stay for the weekend at the house he shares with his irritable landlord Steve. Executive Produced by David Gordon Green. **(World Premiere)**

Constant Fleeting

A poignant exploration of the complex dynamics of family relationships, addiction, grief, and the enduring power of love. At its heart is the story of a decades-long estrangement between an ailing mother and her daughter, which finds unexpected revival through the birth of a grandson. **(World Premiere)**

Docunation

Ten short documentaries exploring diverse lives, from taxidermy enthusiasts to Disney attractions, blending verité, animated, and found footage to present fantastical realities and new perspectives.

I'm Not An Actor

Starring Nawazuddin Siddiqui (*The Lunchbox*) and Chitrangada Satarupa (*Mariam*), the story of two people, one online audition, and their connection that leads to a long video call over a day that unravels their pasts, their fears, their pains, their joys, and leaves each of them forever changed. **(World Premiere)**

In Wintry Season

What seems at first like a fairy tale story of a nun and a priest evolves into a kaleidoscopic examination of gender, fallibility, family inheritance, and the place of faith in a modern world. **(US Premiere)**

Lilly

When a hard-working Alabama factory supervisor discovers her company has been paying her half of what her male counterparts received for 20 years, she begins a historic fight towards justice. Academy Award nominee Patricia Clarkson fiercely portrays the remarkable life of fair pay activist Lilly Ledbetter.
